

Upgrade to an existing Telstra mobile phone base station at Lot 10 Plan 87482 Brookton-Corrigin Road, BULYEE WA 6306 RFNSA reference: 6306004

I am writing on behalf of Telstra to inform Council of a proposed upgrade to an existing mobile phone base station at the above address. The upgrade does not require Development Approval and consultation is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements of Section 7 of the Mobile Phone Base Station Deployment Code 2020.



The upgrade comprises the reconfiguration of six (6) existing panel antennas on the existing guyed mast to provide 5G services.

The upgrade will also include the replacement and/or installation of ancillary equipment including remote radio units, combiners, diplexers, mounts, cable trays, and cables as well as internal works in the existing Telstra equipment shelter.



The proposed upgrade will expand the range of 4G and 5G services provided from the facility, thereby improving network coverage and capacity to the surrounding area.

Where is it being installed?	Lot 10 Plan 87482 Brookton-Corrigin Road, BULYEE WA 6306
What is being installed?	The upgrade comprises the reconfiguration of six (6) existing panel antennas on the existing guyed mast to provide 5G services.
	The upgrade will also include the replacement and/or installation of ancillary equipment including remote radio units, combiners, diplexers, mounts, cable trays, and cables as well as internal works in the existing Telstra equipment shelter.
Does it require Council approval?	No. This upgrade is exempt from Local & State Government approval in accordance with the Telecommunications (Lowimpact Facilities) Determination 2018.
	Community notification is being undertaken in accordance with Section 7 of Mobile Phone Base Station Deployment Code C564:2020.
Does it comply with Australian Standards for Electromagnetic Energy (EME)?	Yes. The proposed infrastructure will be in compliance with the ACMA EME regulatory arrangements. The facility will also comply with Australian government regulations in relation to emission of electromagnetic energy (EME), this specifically being Australian Standard Radiation Protection Series S-1 Standard for Limiting Exposure to Radiofrequency Fields – 100 kHz to 300 GHz published by the Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency (ARPANSA) in 2021.
