PROPOSED LOCAL LAW

The Shire of Corrigin has resolved to make the following local law:

Shire of Corrigin Dogs Local Law 2021

Purpose: to make provisions about the impounding of dogs, to control the number of dogs that can be kept on premises in the district and the manner of keeping those dogs, and to require the removal of dog excreta.

Effect: to extend the control over dogs which exist under the Dog Act 1976 and regulations.

A copy of the proposed law may be inspected at or obtained from the Shire of Corrigin, 9 Lynch Street, Corrigin between the hours of 8.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday or on the website at www.corrigin.wa.gov.au.

Submissions about the proposed law may be made to the Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Corrigin, 9 Lynch Street, Corrigin WA 6375 by 4.30pm 30 April 2021.
