Regular Waste and Recycling Service:

- Place your bins out the night before your collection day
- Lids must open towards the road
- Bins must be placed 50cm apart
- Christmas Day is the only public holiday that will affect your collection - Check the Shire or Avon Waste websites

- Please separate waste for recycle from waste for disposal
- Please follow directions from the facility operator
- Disposal fees may apply - Call the Shire on 9063 2203

Green Waste:

- If you cannot reuse your green waste, take it to the Green Waste Only Collection at the top of Camm Street.

WHAT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- Cardboard** - clean, flattened boxes and cartons
- Paper** - clean, untyped newspaper, magazines, paper, envelopes, telephone books
- Plastic** - clean and empty bottles and containers marked with 1, 2 or 3
- Aluminium** - clean cans, tins and foil
- Steel** - clean cans, tins and aerosol cans
- Liquid paperboard** - clean milk, juice and laundry detergent cartons

WASTE TRANSFER STATION

Open Mon & Wed 10am - 2pm | Fri & Sat 10am - 3pm | Sun 9am - 12pm
Closed: Good Friday, ANZAC Day, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Years Day

Please separate your waste appropriately for disposal and recycling. Talk to the facility operator about what you are disposing of and follow his directions.

Transfer Station facilities include:

- Domestic waste bulk bins
- Cardboard only cages
- Glass only containers
- Car batteries collection
- CFL's & Fluoro tubes
- Recycle bins - see recycling guide opposite
- Building & asbestos-free demolition waste
- Blowworks drums - for commercial used cooking oil
- Scrap metal area
- Used engine oil vessel
- Timber products area
- Paint (dried) disposal
- Household batteries
- drumMUSTER
- MobileMuster

Remember to partake in the drumMUSTER your drums must be triple rinsed and dry before delivery! www.drummuster.com.au

Fees apply for disposal of:

- Septic and liquid waste - is accepted only from DWER licenced contractors with tracking forms
- Asbestos waste - by pre-arranged appointment only for Saturdays. Must be delivered to site double wrapped in heavy duty plastic and labelled **ASBESTOS**.
- Loads in excess of 1 tonne
- Please call the Shire Office on 9063 2203 to organise a disposal permit prior to the anticipated day of delivery, asbestos loads will not be accepted without a permit from the Shire.



CORRIGIN REFUND POINT

Location: 8 Goylder Street, Corrigin
Opening hours: Wed 1pm - 5pm | Sat 8:30am - 12:30pm

- Sign up for a scheme ID at www.containersforchange.com.au
- Collect eligible containers (and remove lids)
- Receive 10 cents per eligible container dropped off at the facility

- 1-200 containers to be dropped off during opening hours only, cash refund to a max of \$20 per person per day or scheme ID refund accepted.
- 200-800 containers to be dropped off during opening hours only, scheme ID refunds only
- 800+ containers require a booking to be made through the Shire office. Booking accepted for Wednesday mornings only and can be made by calling 08 9063 2203.
- Proof of ID in the form of Photo ID/Drivers License is required for more than 825 containers, and a signed declaration is required for anything above 1500 containers in one drop. The refund point operator has the right to refuse to accept containers if the declaration isn't signed.

Ensure containers are free of any smelly/unhealthy residue

Please remember that all containers are sorted and counted by hand, so please bring them in practical containers or bags. Large, heavy bins cannot be handled.

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- Greenwaste** - grass clippings, garden cuttings, leaves and soil
- Electric goods** - computers, mobiles, e-waste ect
- Food Scraps**
- Nappies**
- Styrofoam and polystyrene**
- Plastic Bags**
- Glass** - bottles, jars etc
- Steel products** - except steel cans

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RUBBISH BIN

- Hot or burning ashes
- Bricks, rocks or soil
- Paints or solvents
- Hazardous material, asbestos or chemicals
- Liquid waste
